



Introduction to CPCLL

The Committee to Promote Chinese Language Learning (CPCLL) was established in 2005, following a comprehensive review of the teaching of Chinese Language in Singapore. CPCLL aims to garner support of the community to support the learning of Chinese Language and to facilitate a continuing process of collaboration between schools, community organisations and media; to create an environment for promoting the use of Chinese Language beyond schools. The Committee is currently led by Ms Low Yen Ling, Senior Parliamentary Secretary for Ministry of Education & Ministry of Manpower. Since its formation, CPCLL has actively organised engaging and interactive activities to enthuse students and develop in them an abiding interest in Chinese language and culture. One such activity is the "Script It Right" Chinese Radio Drama Script Writing Competition and Workshops("与声剧来"中文广播剧创作比赛及工作坊).

Introduction to the "Script It Right" Chinese Radio Drama Script Writing Competition and Workshops 2019

The "Script It Right" Chinese Radio Drama Script Writing Competition and Workshops aims to promote the learning of Chinese Language in a fun and interactive way and to stimulate students' interest in the learning of Chinese. It is jointly organised by CPCLL and SPH Chinese Radio Station UFM 100.3. This initiative is targeted at students from secondary schools and tertiary institutions in the bid to provide the opportunities for these students to participate in script writing and sequel writing workshops, as well as the voice talent training camp. Teachers will also be trained to apply similar skills when they are back in their own schools. Selected students will be invited to participate in the recording of winning scripts. Audio recordings of winning scripts will be broadcast on UFM 100.3 after the award ceremony. Details of the competition and a series of workshops in 2019 are as follow:
